Conditions of Entry

NLIS

- All animals entered and exhibited must be the bona fide property of the exhibitor.
 - NLIS tags must be displayed on animals born since January 2006 as required by Meat and Livestock Australia.
 - NLIS information must be completed on the entry form

Eligibility to Show Animals

- Exhibitors must be current financial members of Mohair Australia Limited
 - All animals must have known pedigree and be sired by a registered or registerable buck.
-

Parasites / Animal Health

- Stewards will refuse entry to any animal affected by external parasites, foot rot (hoof trimming should be part of animal show preparation) or obviously in ill health.
 - Such animals must be removed from the Show premises forth with.
 - All animals exhibited must be from properties free of CAE, Johnes and Foot-rot for 12 months prior to the Show.

Check in and Removal of Animals and Fleeces

- Fleeces and animals are to be checked as **"In"** by the Chief Steward prior to judging.
 - Animals may not be loaded on to vehicles until they have been checked as **"Out"** by the Chief Steward.
 - Fleeces may not be removed from the show premises until they have been checked as **"Out"** by the Chief Steward.

Penning

- All animals to be penned by 9.00am Thursday remaining in show until 3.30pm Saturday. Please include on your entry form the number of pens you require including storage pens. All goats over 12 months of age are to be penned separate.
