RULES AND CONDITIONS

- 1) Cavies will be judged in accordance with the standards and general show regulations as provided by the Australian National Cavy Council.
- 2) Immediate family of the judge, on the day, are ineligible to enter pedigree classes, as the cavies are owned by the judge.
- 3) Club show entries for Pedigree classes should be received by the advertised date on the form provided. No late entries will be accepted.
- 4) The steward will call for each class twice if an exhibitor fails to place the cavy on the table the cavy will be scratched.
- 5) The steward is in charge of the running of the pedigree class table and no one is to go behind the judging table while judging is in progress unless instructed.
- 6) The judge's decision is final, no discussion will be entered into at the table.
- 7) No speaking at the table while judging is in progress, unless the judge or steward speaks to you.
- 8) The judge may order any person or cavy from the competition for bad conduct.
- 9) The judge can disqualify any cavy which they think is unfit for showing.
- 10) Method of judging, whether points system or otherwise is left to the discretion of the judge. Best of Breed will be awarded at the judge's discretion.
- 11) Only one handler permitted for each cavy on the judging table. Excluding junior handlers whom need supervision.
- 12) Exhibitors need to be in control of their cavy at all times.
- 13) No substitute animals will be permitted.
- 14) Ill or mite infested cavies will be isolated from the hall.
- 15) Regulation show cages are to be used where possible, or cages with open viewing area permitting a display for the public.
- 16) No hay, straw or sawdust to be taken into the pavilion. Wood shavings are allowed. Any mess to be cleaned up by exhibitors.
- 17) Smoking and drinking alcohol will not be allowed in the hall.
- 18) Cavies purchased from a judge cannot be exhibited under that judge until the expiration of 3 months from the date of purchase.
- 19) All cavies apart from longhairs must be shown on a suitable carpet square or cushion board no bigger than 30 cm by 30 cm of any colour. Long haired cavies should be shown on a cushion board suitable for the length of their coat.
- 20) The Show Society will be most anxious for the care and safety of cavies sent for exhibition or any other property entrusted to it, but it must be clearly understood by exhibitors and all other persons, that the Show society will not be responsible for the loss, detention of or damage to any cavy or other property whether arising from accident or other cause whatsoever or from any act or omission of itself, its officers, agents, servants and others. Unless authorised by the Show Society, no cavy or other animal will be permitted to enter the building other than those entered for exhibition.
