Please note the 2023 Royal Launceston Show will be held at Quercus Park, 415 Oaks Road, Carrick. Sheep Judging will be Thursday 12th October only.

All sheep must be penned by 8am Thursday and must be removed Thursday evening after conclusion of Judging. Times that sheep can be removed will be advised later. Sheep cannot be removed from the showground during show hours.

GENERAL REGULATIONS

All entries are accepted subject to the Rules & Regulations of the Society.

All entries must be from flocks in the Sheep Market Assurance Program (Sheep MAP) or be Approved Vaccinates for Ovine Johnes Disease.

All rams exhibited at the Royal Launceston Show must be from OVINE BRUCELLOSIS FREE FLOCKS and a copy of the CERTIFICATE to be attached to entry form or individually tested within 60 days prior to the Show and certificate provided.

All exhibitors must fill in the Animal Health Declaration and Vendor Declaration attached to the Entry Form.

All sheep entered in this section must be bred in a registered flock.

The Show Society has the right to have all sheep carrying tick or lice removed from the Showgrounds.

JUDGES INSTRUCTIONS - Show Regulations

Class specifications and Breed Standards are at the discretion of the judge.

Sheep entered in General Classes are not eligible to compete in more than one class, with the exception of Special and Group Classes.

All sheep entered in under 1½ year old classes must not be showing more than two permanent teeth. If there are signs of four teeth erupting, an animal is not eligible for exhibition.

If one sheep of a pair is awarded a Championship, the owner of the second prize winning pair has the right of parading the second prize winning pair or the Reserve Championship award.

Should the judge desire to bring out any individual sheep from the pair classes for the championship they may do so.

YOUNG JUDGING COMPETITION

Entrants under 15 years may compete but will not be eligible to compete in the State Final and are not required to pay entry fees.

BREED REGULATIONS

All sheep entered must be registered with their respective breed Societies.

All sheep entered in shorn classes will be accepted on condition that SHORTWOOL SHEEP ARE MACHINE SHORN ON OR AFTER THE 1ST SEPTEMBER AND LONGWOOL SHEEP HAVE WOOL NOT IN EXCESS OF 50mm Poll Dorset and White Suffolk sheep to be shown untrimmed.
