EXHIBITOR CONDITIONS & REGULATIONS

The Dairy Goat Section is run under the Auspices of the Dairy Goat Society of Australia (Tas Branch) *and Exhibitors must be members*. IR registered goats are ineligible to enter.

All goats entered in the Dairy Goat Section are to be penned by 6.00pm Wednesday 11th October, 2023.

TYPE & PRODUCTION TEST CONDITIONS:

Class 18 is open to all Does irrespective of breed. This will consist of a 24 hour milking test, the first milking to take place in the presence of the stewards at 7pm Wednesday of Show week and the Does will be stripped right out. The next two consecutive milkings are at 8am & 7pm the next day, (*Thursday*) to count for the actual test. Milk sample testing will be done by TASHERD.

Any Doe in milk, not entered in this class must be stripped out in the presence of stewards at 7.00pm on *Thursday* prior to judging.

DAIRY GOATS MAY NOT LEAVE UNTIL AFTER 3.30PM SATURDAY

To ensure compliance with fire brigade regulations, no flame of any description is permitted in livestock pavilions.

DAIRY GOAT CLASSES

Class 1: Saanen Doe in milk, 1st lactation
Class 2: Toggenburg Doe in milk, 1st lactation
Class 3: British Alpine Doe in milk, 1st lactation
Class 4: Anglo Nubian Doe in milk, 1st lactation
Class 5: Australian Melaan Doe in milk 1st lactation
Class 6: Australian Brown Doe in milk 1st lactation
Class 7: Any Other Breed Doe in milk 1st lactation (Specify Breed)

Class 8: Saanen Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 9: Toggenburg Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 10: British Alpine Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 11: Anglo Nubian Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 12: Australian Melaan Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 13: Australian Brown Doe in milk, 2nd or subsequent lactation
Class 14: Any Other Breed Doe in milk 2nd subsequent lactation (Specify Breed)
Class 14A: Dry Doe any Breed, Doe must have kidded at least once

To compete in the following * classes, does must have competed in a lactation class above (1-14)

*Class 15: Veteran Doe in milk, any breed, over 6 yrs.
*Class 16: Best Udder, any breed, 1st lactation
*Class 17: Best Udder, any breed, 2nd or subsequent lactation

JUDGING OF BEST UDDER OVERALL. (All does to be milked out during classes 16 & 17. Milk must not be disposed of on the grounds.)

Class 18 One Day Production any Breed, any Lactation:

Qualification for this class: A min. 3kgs of milk for standard size Does. (1kg for Nigerian Dwarf) and a minimum of 3% butterfat is required to qualify. Results for One Day Production Test held at the Royal Launceston Show will be used in Class 18 at the Royal Launceston Show venue.

Milk points will be calculated as follows: for production, Q* points. Judges Type points, to a maximum of 100 will be awarded.

Type and Production classes: T&P card from Milk Awards Co-ordinator must be supplied to Steward before the show begins. Exception – results of One Day Production Test held at Royal Launceston Show will be used in Class 18*

*Class 18: One Day Production. Type & Production, any breed, any lactation,
*Class 19: Herd Recording. Type & Production, any breed, any lactation,

Class 20: Saanen Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 21: Toggenburg Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 22: British Alpine Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 23: Anglo Nubian Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 24: Australian Melaan Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 25: Australian Brown Goatling, 12-24 months unkidded
Class 26: Any Other Breed Goatling 12-24 months unkidded (Specify Breed)

JUDGING OF BREED CHAMPIONS

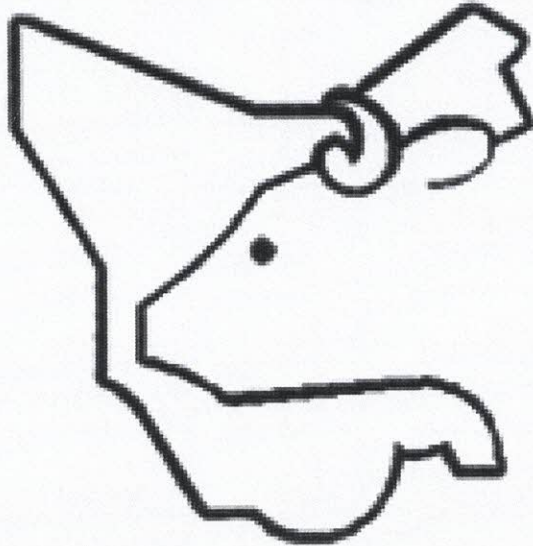
